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### **Cisco Asa Firewall Syslog Asa**

Choose Configuration > Features > Properties > Logging > Logging Setup. Check the Enable logging check box in order to enable syslogs. In order to configure an external server as the destination for syslogs, choose Syslog Servers in Logging and click Add in order to add a syslog server.

### **ASA Syslog Configuration Example - Cisco**

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This section provides the following new or changed logging information for ASA. Timestamp Logging: Beginning with version 9.10 (1), ASA provides the option to enable timestamp as per RFC 5424 in eventing syslog. When this option is enabled, all timestamp of syslog messages would be displaying the time as per RFC 5424 format.

The ASA does not send severity 0, emergency messages to the syslog server. These are analogous to a UNIX panic message, and denote an unstable system. Alert Messages, Severity 1  
Critical Messages, Severity 2

The Cisco ASA firewall generates syslog messages for many

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different events. For example, interfaces going up or down, security alerts, debug information and more. We can configure the ASA to tell it how much and where to store logging information. Before you configure logging, make sure your clock has been configured.

The ASA generates a syslog message at the first hit and at the  
end of each interval, identifying the total number of hits during  
the interval and the time stamp for the last hit. At the end of  
each interval, the ASA resets the hit count to 0.

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You need to first of all enable logging on the ASDM. Then under syslog server select the syslog server you need to send the logs to. 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### **Solved: Set up a SYSLOG Server - ASA - Cisco Community**

You need to have a server running a syslog daemon (or ftp server). Then configure that server's IP address as the destination for your ASA's log messages. You can do the latter from the command line or ASDM GUI, depending on your preference. The configuration guides for the ASA tell you how step-by-step. They are all posted here.

Cisco ASA Cisco ASA is one of the few event sources that can handle multiple types of logs on a single port because it hosts Firewall and VPN logs. For the InsightIDR parser to work, make sure that your Cisco ASA appliance has "logging timestamp" turned on and the "logging host" has been configured for the InsightIDR collector.

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
