A guide coat is a light misting of paint or primer in a contrasting color above each coat of primer. I use rattle-can "sandable primer." In Figure 1 you can see that the guide coat (black) is misted over the primer coat (grey). The purpose of this coat will become obvious as you begin to sand the primer. Next time we'll go over the process of sanding down this guide coat and you'll see exactly what function the guide coat serves.

#### **Block Sanding BONDO-Using A Guide Coat**

Typically we use a black guide coat over the gray primer. After the guide coat is applied, we will use long sanding blocks to sand the guide coat off. What will happen is that the guide coat will sand off of the high spots, and will stay in place in any low spots. This will allow us to see any imperfections. If the low spots are low enough we will use a glaze to very lightly build up the surface. Then we will prime, sand and guide coat again.

The process of guide coat is fairly simple. Typically you do your body filler and seal the repairs with gray primer. From there you can apply a contrasting color guide coat (usually black over gray primer or tan guide coat over black primer). The guide coat is misted onto the surface leaving a spotty looking finish.

By spraying a contrasting color over the primer, when sanded the guide coat quickly come of the high spots, and stays in the low spots guiding where you need to further block. Guide coat is like no build paint, sanding off with the least effort possible.

Apply gel coat to mold surface. Spraying gel coat is recommended for more accurate and consistent coverage. Apply gel coat in 4-5 layers at approximately 5 mils each, allowing 15-20 minutes between layers for a total thickness of 20-25 mils. Use #122-A Gel Coat Thickness Gauge to ensure proper thickness is achieved.
