For OCR to establish jurisdiction, the complaint must allege, or OCR must be able to infer from the facts given, an allegation of: 1) discrimination based on race, color, national origin, sex, disability or age, 2) discrimination in violation of the Boy Scouts of America Equal Access Act, or 3) retaliation for the purpose of interfering with any right or privilege secured by the civil rights laws enforced by OCR, or as a result of making a complaint, testifying, or participating in any ...
